






# Our Pastoral System

When starting at St Bede's, each student is allocated to a Tutor Group within the year.



The tutor oversees a child's welfare and development in school, normally remaining with their group from Year 7 to Year 11.


Year Leaders will also remain with their year cohort from Year 7 through to Year 11.





- Bespoke support: 1-2-1 visits to school out of hours; additional meetings




