

I belong to a community of **faith**, **hope** and **love**.



- Plain black formal leather/faux leather school shoes
- Plain black opaque tights or black socks.

- No Visible branding















The first week of their timetable students will be **collected and returned** to the Y7 yard.




Year 7 will have an **early lunch** for the first full week






